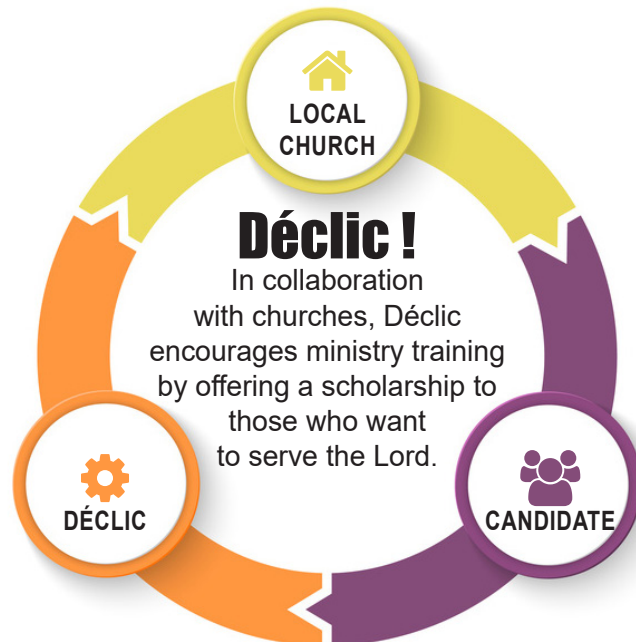

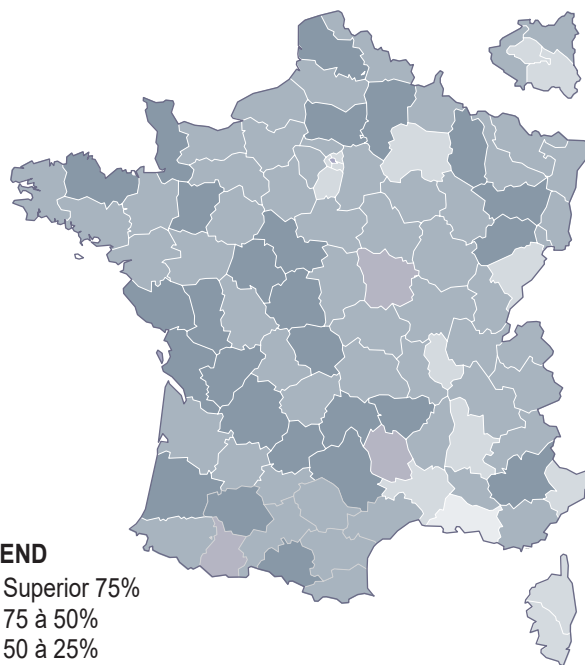
General Need in France



The map at left, while it is approximate, shows the needs for evangelization in France. The statistics are based on the population of each department and the number of known evangelicals.

The map show low probability for an unbeliever to find a church. In light of this we can conclude that France is still a mission field.
